DISPOSITION OF CASES SET FOR TRIAL/PRETRIAL THE WEEKS OF FEBRUARY 15th, 2010

DEPARTMENT 1

JUDGE SALTER

#1234900 Defendant James Oliver Haberkam. After a two-week jury trial that began February 1st in Department 1 before Judge Salter on the felony charges of Attempted Murder, Assault With a Deadly Weapon, and Threatening to Commit a Crime Resulting in Great Bodily Injury or Death, the jury found the defendant guilty of Premeditated Attempted Murder with the use of a firearm, and Assault With a Firearm causing great bodily injury. Sentencing is scheduled for March 16th in Department 1. Deputy District Attorney Nate Baker prosecuted the case for the People.

#1403962 Defendant Donovan Ray Vonlindern. Set for jury trial February 22nd in Department 1 before Judge Salter on the misdemeanor charge of Being a Driver in Possession of Marijuana. The trial date was vacated after the defendant pled guilty and was ordered to pay specified fines.
