Modesto, California – On Tuesday, December 10, 2002, the Victim Services Unit of the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office will be sponsoring the fifth annual Memorial Christmas Ceremony in remembrance of crime victims. The ceremony will be held at 6:30 p.m. on the front lawn of the County Courthouse located at 1100 "I" Street, Modesto. District Attorney Jim Brazelton will host the ceremony which will begin with the lighting of the Homicide Victims' Memorial Tree. The program includes speakers Matt Schrader, Chaplain for the Modesto Police Department; Linda McFadden, President of the Stanislaus County Peace Officers' Association; and several friends and family of homicide victims.

A candlelight vigil will follow. Friends and family of victims will be invited to hang a non-breakable ornament on the tree in remembrance of their loved ones who are not here to celebrate the holiday season due to the criminal acts of others. Caroling and refreshments will be provided by the Salvation Army and the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office. Friends and family of crime victims are invited to attend and bring a non-breakable ornament to hang on the tree in memory of their loved one.
