MODESTO, CALIFORNIA – Stanislaus County District Attorney James Brazelton announced today that Robert Bue, age 19, of Modesto, was charged today on two counts of premeditated and deliberate murder, two counts of premeditated attempted murder, committing the crimes for the benefit of a gang, and using a gun to commit the crimes. Bue was also charged with special circumstances of multiple murders, lying in wait and committing the murders for the benefit of a gang, making Bue eligible for the death penalty. The case arose out of events which occurred on May 1, 2004 in the city of Modesto on J St.

Deputy District Attorney Michael Houston appeared at the arraignment for the People and requested Bue be held without bail. The Honorable Michael Cummins agreed and Bue was remanded without bail. Arraignment was continued to January 25, 2005.
