Modesto, California – Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that Glenn Gary, 59, of Modesto was found unsuitable for parole at a March 21st hearing of the State Board of Prison Terms at Folsom State Prison. Deputy District Attorney Richard Gore appeared at the hearing and argued for continued confinement based on the danger that Gary may pose to the public should he be released into the community. The Board of Prison Terms denied parole stating that Gary would pose an unreasonable risk to public safety if he were to be paroled.

Gary was convicted of the March 11, 1981 murder of Casey Wallace. At the time of the murder, Gary was the president of the Bar Hoppers motorcycle gang. He was heavily involved in the manufacture and sale of methamphetamine. On March 11, 1981, Gary lured Wallace to a location in Keyes where he beat him and shot him in the head three times. Gary believed that Wallace was involved in a plan to assassinate him. On August 19, 1982, a jury convicted Gary of first degree murder with the use of a firearm. He is serving a 27 year to life prison sentence. This was Gary's fifth parole hearing. Another hearing will be scheduled in 2008.
