Re: Victor Camarena- Robber is sentenced to

26 years in state prison

Modesto, California - Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that Victor Camarena, age 26, of Keyes, was convicted of robbery with use of a gun, felony in possession of firearm, felon in possession of ammunition and felony evading on May 20, 2009. Camarena also admitted he had a prior felony conviction that falls under California's "Three Strikes" law. Deputy District Attorney Shawn D. Bessey prosecuted the case for the People.

The case arose out of events that occurred on March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008 in the city of Modesto. Camarena robbed the victim of his wallet and car keys at gun point and fled in the victim's car. Camarena was spotted several days later by a Modesto Police officer. Camarena, who was a passenger in a car, put the car in gear and forced the driver to drive away at a high rate of speed. The driver lost control of the vehicle and crashed. Camarena ran from the police but was apprehended a short distance away. Officers found live ammunition in Camarena's pocket.

Upon entry of the guilty plea, the Honorable Nancy Ashley sentenced the defendant to 26 years in state prison. He must serve at least 85% of his time before he will be eligible for parole.
