Auto Thief Sentenced to 3 Years State Prison

Modesto, California Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that Thomas Patrick Day, age 28, of Modesto, was convicted of possession of a stolen vehicle. Day also admitted a prior prison commitment stemming from a June 2006 conviction for auto theft for which he is currently on parole. Deputy District Attorney Jeff Mangar prosecuted the case for the People.

On March 14, 2009 at approximately 9:00 a.m., the victim noticed that his 1991 black Acura Integra had been stolen from the front of his house in Modesto.

Three days later on March 17, 2009, at approximately 8:00 a.m. in the area of Orange Street in Modesto, officers from the Stanislaus County Auto-Theft Task Force (STANCATT) observed Day driving the vehicle. After performing a vehicle stop, the officers observed that Day had two duffel bags full of clothing in the stolen vehicle and a shaved key in the ignition.

Upon entry of the plea, the Honorable Thomas Zeff sentenced Day to three years in state prison.
