Modesto, California - Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that James Leroy Graves, Jr., age 40, of Modesto, was convicted on August 13, 2009 after a four-day jury trial of Driving Under the Influence (DUI), having a blood alcohol concentration of .15 percent or more. Deputy District Attorney Merrill Hoult prosecuted the case for the People.

The case arose out of events that occurred on January 9, 2009. At approximately 2:15 p.m., a red pickup truck crashed into a sign located at the intersection of McHenry Avenue and Fairmont Avenue in Modesto. Witnesses saw Graves seated in the driver's seat of the truck. Graves reversed the pickup truck travelling about three feet and attempted to flee the scene. However, Graves was unable to leave due to the extensive damage to the truck. When a witness attempted to call 911 for assistance, Graves threatened the witness. Officers from the Modesto Police Department arrived and detained Graves. Graves had objective symptoms of intoxication and performed field sobriety tests consistent with a person who was under the influence of alcohol. A blood test later revealed that Graves's blood alcohol level was .18%.

The Honorable Donald Shaver then sentenced Graves to 30 days in jail, a \$1521 fine, alcohol treatment, enhanced DUI classes, and standard fines and fees.
