Modesto, California - Stanislaus County District Attorney Birgit Fladager announced today that Brian Joseph Gomes, age 41, of Turlock, was convicted and sentenced on December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016 to eight years state prison for possessing heroin for sale and possessing a controlled substance while in possession of a firearm. Deputy District Attorney Heather M. Melton prosecuted the case on behalf of the People.

On July 22, 2016, Turlock Police stopped Gomes for a traffic violation and lawfully searched his vehicle. The officer located a hidden storage compartment containing a black zippered bag holding a loaded 9mm pistol and several baggies of methamphetamine.

One week later, on July 30, 2016, the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office served a search warrant at Gomes's home in Turlock. Gomes was found hiding in the attic. Inside his bedroom, deputies located packaging material consistent with someone selling drugs.

On December 16<sup>th</sup> Gomes pleaded to the charges and also admitted that he was previously convicted in 2010 of negligent discharge of a firearm, a "Strike" under California's Three Strikes Law, which was used to double his sentence. Judge Scott T. Steffen then sentenced Joseph Brian Gomes to 8 years in state prison.
